|-------------|------|----------|---------|---------------|------------|
| I           | WAS  | I        | WASN'T  | WAS           | I ... ?    |
| YOU         | WERE | YOU      | WEREN'T | WERE          | YOU ... ?  |
| HE          | WAS  | HE       | WASN'T  | WAS           | HE ... ?   |
| SHE         |      | SHE      |         |               | SHE ... ?  |
| IT          |      | IT       |         |               | IT ... ?   |
| WE          | WERE | WE       | WEREN'T | WERE          | WE ... ?   |
| YOU         |      | YOU      |         |               | YOU ... ?  |
| THEY        |      | THEY     |         |               | THEY ... ? |

# SIMPLE PAST – ADVERBS OF TIME

- AGO

- ✓ I was at the cafeteria 10 minutes ago.

- YESTERDAY

- ✓ We were at Brian's house yesterday.

- THE DAY BEFORE YESTERDAY

- ✓ Was she playing LOL the day before yesterday?

- LAST (WEEK – MONTH – YEAR)

- ✓ Jack and Lindsay weren't in Italy last month.

# SIMPLE PAST - REGULAR

## TO TALK

| <b>TO WALK</b>     |                         |                       |
|--------------------|-------------------------|-----------------------|
| <b>Affirmative</b> | <b>Negative</b>         | <b>Interrogative</b>  |
| <b>I walked</b>    | <b>I didn't walk</b>    | <b>Did I walk?</b>    |
| <b>You walked</b>  | <b>You didn't walk</b>  | <b>Did you walk?</b>  |
| <b>He walked</b>   | <b>He didn't walk</b>   | <b>Did he walk?</b>   |
| <b>We walked</b>   | <b>We didn't walk</b>   | <b>Did we walk?</b>   |
| <b>They walked</b> | <b>They didn't walk</b> | <b>Did they walk?</b> |

# SIMPLE PAST - ED

- Add 'ed' to the verb:
- Start → started
- Finish → finished
- Verbs ending with 'e', add just 'd'
- Arrive → arrived
- Survive → Survived

| Eat     | Ate    | Comer          |
| Fall    | Fell   | Cair           |
| Go      | Went   | Ir             |
| Have    | Had    | Ter            |
| Know    | Knew   | Saber          |
| Leave   | Left   | Deixar; Partir |
| Say     | Said   | Dizer          |
| See     | Saw    | Ver            |
| Sleep   | Slept  | Dormir         |
| Speak   | Spoke  | Falar          |
| Take    | Took   | Levar; Pegar   |
| Tell    | Told   | Dizer; Contar  |
| Write   | Wrote  | Escrever       |

# SIMPLE PAST

## TO SEE

- AFFIRMATIVE

I saw your sister on the street yesterday.

- NEGATIVE

I didn't see your sister on the street yesterday.

- INTERROGATIVE

Did you see my sister on the street yesterday?
